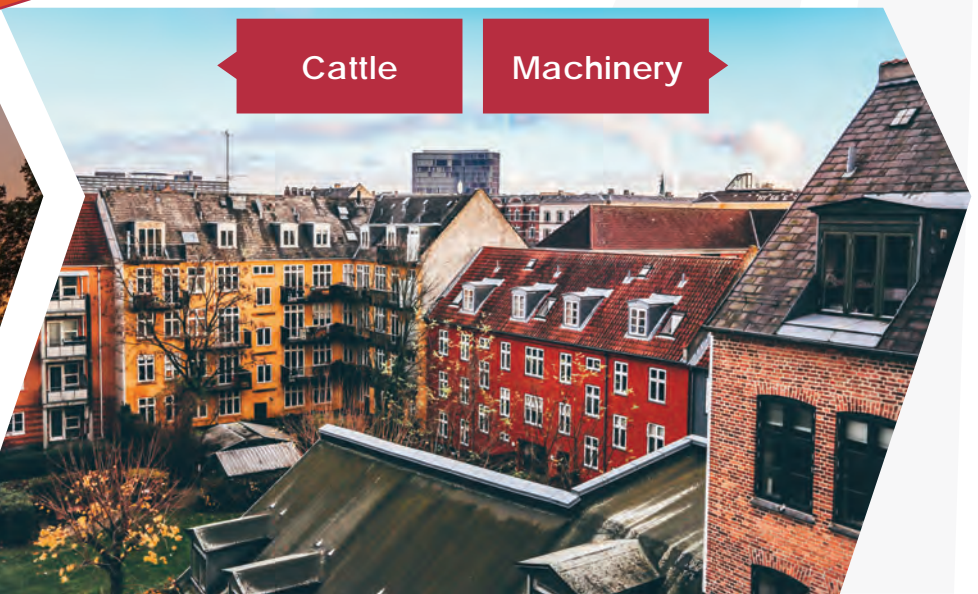

## In order to qualify

- Be between the ages of 19 and 29 by the time you depart on your program.
- Be a current Agricultural student where you are then required to do an industry placement and then be returning back to resume your studies.
- Be in good mental and physical health.
- Free of any criminal record.
- Be able to understand and communicate in English. You must also pass a language test in English at A2-level or higher.
- Be mature, flexible, open-minded, committed and willing to adjust (weather, culture, food, temperature, etc.).
- Have a drivers license

## Wages

Your experience and age will determine your wages. Generally an intern will roughly earn 1100 Euro's based on a 37-hour work week, for the first 6 months and 1400 Euro's the last 6 months. The Danish have a great work and life balance, therefore give your all during your working hours and relax during our time off. Work, play hard!

You will receive 5 weeks paid holiday during your 12 months. If you don't take leave, you will receive the pay for those 5 weeks.

## Accommodation and meals

A private room with a shared bathroom, kitchen and living area is usually what interns can expect, but it all depends on the property and the number of interns. Sometimes interns stay in the farmers house with the family or have a private area in the house. Your price for accommodation will be around 200-300 Euro.

You will have to buy and make your own food, which will work out at 100 - 150 Euro per month.
